## **STUDENT AFFAIRS**

### **MSM Health Insurance 2016-2017**

1. ALL full-time Manhattan School of Music students are required to have health insurance that meets the **minimum essential coverage** requirements set forth by the U.S. Affordable Care Act.
2. ALL full-time Manhattan School of Music students will be pre-enrolled in the plan and charged via their student bill. \*Exemptions: Enrollment is voluntary for Part-time and DMA students in their 3rd year and beyond. Exchange students are subject to exchange agreement and visa requirements, but are not mandated to enroll on the MSM-sponsored plan.
3. The MSM health insurance policy is MANDATORY for all F-1 and J-1 visa holders entering a new program beginning in 2016-17. \*International and travel health insurance plans are no longer be accepted.
4. All domestic students and those continuing F-1 and J-1 visa holders who enrolled at MSM before the 2016-2017 academic year will be allowed to submit an **online waiver application** through the student insurance portal and will be granted a waiver of the school-sponsored plan under certain conditions. \***Paper waiver requests are no longer accepted.**  
  
\*Waiver applications submitted after the **waiver deadline** will incur a **\$100 late fee** that will be added to your student account bill.
5. To be eligible to waive the school-sponsored health insurance plan your individual/private plan:
  - a. Must be valid in New York State.
  - b. Must be effective no later than August 20<sup>th</sup>
    - For full-time students enrolled for Fall – Spring academic year, 1- full year of coverage is required August 20<sup>th</sup> – August, 19<sup>th</sup>.
    - For students graduating in the Fall, coverage is required through December 31<sup>st</sup>
  - c. New York State Medicaid will be accepted.
6. Students who are approved to waive the MSM-sponsored health insurance plan and are covered by another health insurance provider should contact their health insurance provider directly or go online to their customer service webpage to request information for local medical providers, urgent care centers and clinics authorized to provide services. ALL students are encouraged to organize a list of medical care providers in the area, including contact information, that accept their individual insurance plan prior to arriving at Manhattan School of Music.

### **Student Health Insurance Plan**

The MSM-sponsored health insurance plan will cover the student for one full academic year, August 20<sup>th</sup> – August 19<sup>th</sup>. Enrollment is for the full year and cannot be changed. If a student takes a leave of absence, withdraws, or changes to part-time status prior to the academic year end, their coverage under the plan will continue through the end of the enrollment period and NO REFUNDS will be issued.

Students must have their health insurance card with them at all times to receive medical services.
