

Navigating the MTA:

Information on NYC Public Transit

Pay-Per-Ride (Regular) Metro Card

\$2.25 per ride. Put \$8 or more on your card & receive a 15 percent bonus.

- You get an automatic free transfer between subway & bus, or between buses.
- You may also pay with exact change (no bills accepted) to ride a bus. If you pay with exact change & plan to transfer, ask the driver for a transfer pass.

Unlimited Metrocard

- **1-Day Fun Pass \$8.25**
Good for unlimited subway & local bus rides from first use until 3 AM the following day.
- **7-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard \$27**
Good for unlimited subway & local bus rides until midnight of 7th day from first use.
- **14-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard \$51.50**
Good for unlimited subway & local bus rides until midnight of 14th day from first use. This card is protected against loss of theft when purchased at a vending machine with a creditor debit/ATM card.
- **30-Day Unlimited Ride MetroCard \$89**
Good for unlimited subway and local bus rides until midnight, 30 days from day of first use. This card is protected against loss of theft when purchased at a vending machine with a creditor debit/ATM card.

Closest Subway/Bus Stops to MSM:

Subway

- **1 train** (which runs on the West side of Manhattan from North to South) 116th street or the 125th street stop. Both stops are on Broadway.
- **A, B, C, D trains** (which run along Central Park West from North to South) on 125th street.

Bus

- Bus stops are available on Broadway at 120th, 122nd, 124th, etc. (every 2 blocks).
- **M4 bus** runs from 32nd street & 7th avenue on the East side up to the Cloisters.
- **M104 bus** runs from 42nd street & 1st avenue until 125th street & Amsterdam Avenue

Cross Town Buses:

M57 (runs on 59th street) **M66** (runs on 67th/68th street) **M79** (runs on 79th street)

M86 (runs on 79th street) **M86** (runs on 86th street) **M96** (runs on 96th street)

These busses run West to East (and vice versa) & are helpful in getting to the opposite side of Manhattan.

Subway trains run 24 hours, 7 days per week.
