

MSM Rental Tech Specs Pforzheimer Recital Hall



Home to one of the School's harpsichords, Carl and Lily Pforzheimer Hall is a favorite hall for baroque performance, and it is also used for presentations by MSM groups such as the Center for Music Entrepreneurship. With its high ceilings and resonant acoustics, it is also popular for vocal and chamber recitals.

Seating Capacity

- Total capacity: 53

Stage Dimensions

- Total stage area square footage: 12'1" x 16'10", one step stage right 1'.
- Room dimensions: 18'4" W x 39'8" L from wall to wall

Lighting Capability

- 3 hanging chandeliers over audience
- 4 Fresnel lights (2 on each side) for front light onstage
- Controls are located by the house door and house right rear

Pianos

- One 7' Steinway B
- Harpsicord
- Upright piano (practice, not performance)

Usual Setups

Pforzheimer Hall has configurable seating for 53 at maximum, with a standard center recital setup facing the 1' elevated stage. Any configuration of chairs is possible, and 6- and 8-foot tables can be made available upon request

A/V Capability

Audio:

- Audio playback is available via a rack that includes a CD player, turntable, cassette player, and 1/8" AUX cable that is connected to stereo audio speakers mounted in the back of the hall. This is intended more for lecture/class playback, not live sound amplification related to a performance.

- Multi-track audio recording services are available upon request from the MSM Distance Learning and Recording Arts Department.
