ABOUT THE ARTIST

Jim McNeely

Born in Chicago, Jim McNeely received his B.Mus. in composition from the University of Illinois in 1975 and moved to New York City. He joined the Thad Jones/Mel Lewis Jazz Orchestra in 1978 and spent six years as a featured soloist with that band and its successor, Mel Lewis and the Jazz Orchestra (now the Vanguard Jazz Orchestra). In 1981 Jim began his four-year tenure as pianist/composer with the Stan Getz Quartet. From 1990 until 1995 he held the piano chair in the Phil Woods Quintet. At the present time, he leads his own tentet and trio and appears as soloist at concerts and festivals worldwide.

As composer/arranger and conductor for large jazz bands, Jim has earned 12 Grammy nominations; his reputation continues to flourish. In 1996 he re-joined the Vanguard Jazz Orchestra as pianist and composer-in residence. He is the former chief conductor, and current composer-in-residence, with the Frankfurt Radio Big Band, where he has collaborated on projects with artists such as Dave Holland, John Scofield, Luciana Souza, Branford Marsalis, Dave Douglas, Ambrose Akinmusire, and many others. Other recent work includes projects with the Danish Radio Big Band, where he was chief conductor for five years, the Metropole Orchestra (Netherlands), the Swiss Jazz Orchestra, the Frankfurt Radio Symphony Orchestra, and the Jazz Orchestra of the Concertgebouw. The New York Times has called his writing "exhilarating"; DownBeat has said that his music is "eloquent enough to be profound." He won a Grammy for his work on the Vanguard Jazz Orchestra's Monday Night Live at the Village Vanguard on Planet Arts Records.

Jim has appeared as sideman on numerous recordings led by major artists such as Thad Jones, Mel Lewis, Stan Getz, Bob Brookmeyer, and Phil Woods. The latest of his numerous albums under his own name is *Rituals*, with the Frankfurt Radio Big Band and Chris Potter, "a fascinating listen" given five stars by *DownBeat*. Ed Enright lauded it in his review as "a dramatic homage of breathtaking breadth and sophistication that succeeds on every level."

Teaching is also an important part of Jim's work. Now professor emeritus of jazz composition at Manhattan School of Music, he joined the faculty in 2008. He has held positions at William Paterson University and New York University and for 24 years was involved with the BMI Jazz Composers Workshop, including 16 as musical director. He has appeared at numerous college jazz festivals in the U.S. as performer and clinician and has done clinics and major residencies at dozens of institutions in the U.S., Canada, Europe, Japan, China, Australia, New Zealand, and Egypt.

THE CENTENNIAL PROJECT

Manhattan School of Music's Centennial Project was an ambitious program of improvements to the School's architecturally distinguished campus coinciding with MSM's 100th anniversary. The centerpiece of the Project was the renovation of Neidorff-Karpati Hall, MSM's principal performance space, which has been transformed into a state-of-the-art venue to showcase our talented students. Built in 1931 and designed by Shreve, Lamb & Harmon, the architects of the Empire State Building, the hall has been called "one of the Art Deco treats in the city" by the New York Times. The Project also included a dramatic and welcoming new campus entrance on Claremont Avenue, new practice rooms, and an expansion of the main entryway and lobby.


