Whitney Museum

Location: 945 Madison Avenue at 75th Street

- The Whitney's collection—comprising more than 19,000 paintings, sculptures, drawings, prints, photographs, films, videos, and new media by more than 2,900 artists—contains some of the most significant and exciting work created by artists in the United States during the twentieth and twenty-first centuries.
- Students receive a discounted rate of \$24. Proof of ID is required upon arrival.
- All visitors 25 and under receive free admission everyday, but you must reserve tickets ahead of time on the website.
- Admission to the Whitney is now free from 5-10pm every Friday evening and free all day on the second Sunday of every month.
