Justin Bischof is one of the most eclectic artists and leaders of his generation. He is an internationally acclaimed orchestral and opera conductor as well as a concert organist, pianist, and improviser. He has performed in some of the world's great venues including New York's Carnegie Hall, Alice Tully Lincoln Center, Rose Theatre Lincoln Center, Tonhalle of Zurich, Eli Broad Theatre of Los Angeles, Royal Opera House Oman, St. Paul's Cathedral London, Notre Dame Paris, and Cologne Cathedral.

Founded by Justin Bischof, Modus Operandi Orchestra MOO of New York City, is comprised of some of the finest freelance orchestral players in the country.

### CHLOE KIFFER, Violin

She made her Carnegie Hall Stern Auditorium debut as soloist in Tchaikovsky's Violin Concerto and has since appeared at Lincoln Center, Salle Gaveau, Salle Cortot, Shanghai Oriental Art Center, in Israel, and in Seoul—among many halls worldwide. Kiffer is Professor of Violin and Chamber Music at the Manhattan School of Music and is regularly invited to festivals including the Heifetz Institute, MusicAlps, the Académie Internationale de Musique in Paris, Music Fest Perugia, Kaufman SummerFest, Artists of Korea, and the Texas Chamber Music Institute.
