

Reduced-fee Neuropsychological Testing in NYC

University training clinics are a good resource for affordable neuropsychological testing on a sliding scale. Staffed by doctoral students and supervised by licensed psychologists, these clinics typically offer comprehensive ADHD and other neuropsychological evaluations at significantly lower rates than private practice (often \$500–\$1,500 vs. \$5,000+).

1. The Psychological Center (City College of New York)

Located in Harlem, this training clinic of the City College of New York clinical psychology doctoral program offers some of the most affordable sliding-scale testing in the city, including comprehensive neuropsychological and psychoeducational evaluations.

2. The Dean Hope Center for Educational and Psychological Services (Columbia Teachers College)

The training clinic of Columbia University Teachers College offers a comprehensive psychoeducational battery that assesses for learning disabilities and ADHD as well as other conditions.

4. Parnes Clinic (Yeshiva University)

This is one of the largest training clinics in the city, which offers testing for ADHD and learning disorders as well as other psychological evaluations. They are located in the Bronx, their capacity is often higher than smaller clinics.
